








<u>Bestseller Collection Display</u> <u>& LibGuide</u>

New Bestseller Fiction/Nonfiction Collection

SBU University Libraries is unveiling a new collection this fall - **bestseller fiction and nonfiction**! Over the past several years students have periodically asked us for popular titles, which were not purchased due to a predominantly academic collection development policy. As a result of SBU University Libraries' new vision to "bring the library to you" and an evolving collection development policy, we believe that this collection will further enhance the services made available to SBU faculty and students. Books will be selected in the **genres of mystery/suspense**, **literary/science/historical fiction**, **biography**, **cooking/crafts**, **as well as other pop culture areas**. Sometime during the first few weeks of the Fall 2013 semester, **45 titles** will become available to checkout. New titles will be added to the collection monthly and will be displayed at the front of the library.


Hutchens Library purchases bestseller collection
